

FOURTH GRADE NOTIFICATION 5TH GRADE SAFETY PATROL SELECTION PROCESS

Welcome Fourth Graders and Parents,

The eligibility process of the Fifth Grade Safety Patrols has begun. In order to become a 5th grade safety patrol 4th grade students must be recommended by their 4th grade teacher.

Selection is based on qualities of a safety patrol: dependability, good behavior, consistency in academics and leadership. Consideration is also based on student interest, sense of responsibility, attitude toward others and academic behavior (completion of class assignments and homework in all classes including Specials).

When the Safety Patrol Sponsor invites a student to apply, they will complete an application signed by their parent(s)/guardian(s) and teacher(s). Safety Patrols in Training (SPIT) will occur in three phases. The first two rounds will take place during the fourth quarter of 4th grade and the third round in the beginning of fifth grade.

Desirable qualities to keep in mind when selecting members of the school safety patrol are:

- 1. Leadership
- 2. Responsible and Safety
- 3. Punctuality
- 4. Positive behavior representing Franklin Academy while on campus and off during field trips
- 5. Academic Responsibility completing assignments and homework in all subjects including specials
- 6. Observes school, classroom and teacher rules
- 7. Good Attendance record
- 8. Courtesy considers the feelings of others
- 9. Respectful
- 10. Attitude of service to others

Please remind your student the qualities needed to be a safety patrol. Students with any suspensions and/or detentions will not qualify.
